Decision making

Applications will be assessed by a panel against the criteria set out in the Guidance Document, using the approach outlined above.

Successful applications will be those that:

- 1) Meet all the eligibility criteria (assessment stage 1 of this document)
- 2) Meet the aims of the fund (assessment stage 2 of this document)
- 3) Are scored the highest by the panel
